



Hurricane Personal Equipment for Crew Activation Assignments

In the event LSEMS Crews are activated for a weather event, below are the items that you must bring with you to your assignment. (You can print this checklist.)

- ❑ At least three (3) gallons of drinking water.
- ❑ Non-perishable food sufficient for three (3) days, with ice and cooler.
- ❑ Personal medication for three (3) days
- ❑ Extra contacts or glasses.
- ❑ Personal bedding:
 - ❑ Sleeping bag or pillow & blanket.
 - ❑ Personal air mattress, if available.
- ❑ Normal work implements (scissors, stethoscope, etc)
- ❑ Other work implements:
 - ❑ Small backup flashlight with extra batteries.
 - ❑ Buck style folding knife, if available.
 - ❑ Small personal cooler to carry on unit.
- ❑ Extra uniforms:
 - ❑ At least three (3) complete changes, including underwear and socks. (Class A's are not required.)
 - ❑ Extra work boots, if you have them.
 - ❑ Extra shoelaces.
- ❑ Personal hygiene items for three (3) days:
 - ❑ Soap
 - ❑ Toiletries
 - ❑ Towels
- ❑ Issued Rescue Gear.
- ❑ For storage of your personal items, either water-resistant containers or plastic trash bags.
